Japanese Language NAT TEST Report

The Japanese Language NAT TEST was conducted on 9th April 2017 in SIOM. Mr. Satoshi KAMATA (Director Senmon Kyouiku Co.Ltd.) was personally present to guide and to conduct the test as it was being the “First All India” exam to be held in STES (Pune Centre).

There were total 81 examinees appeared for April 17 NAT TEST. 75% of the examinees were from different parts of Maharashtra like – Mumbai, Nagpur, Aurangabad, Satara, Nasik, Kolhapur and Amaravati. The level wise break up is as follows:

- a) Q5 – basic level – total no. of examinees were 48
- b) Q4 - second level – total no. of examinees were 12
- c) Q3 – 3rd level – total no. of examinees were 21

The next NAT TEST exam will be on 11th June 2017 for all 5 levels.

Considering the future Japanese investments in India and the scope for Japanese learners the emphasis was given to fluent Japanese verbal communication & virtual classroom to be established in STES.

April 17 NAT TEST result was announced within 12days after the exam on Senmon Kyouiku’s Japan website i.e. on 19/04/2017. On 19th April, only passed examinees numbers were displayed /and the hard copies (certificate & score sheet) we received on April 28/4/17. Following are the details:
