Dear Students,

I hope all of you are now engrossed in your Summer Internship Projects. You are going through various phases of learning including, corporate etiquette, email / telephone etiquette, grass route level challenges and many more. Some of you

might have started to rethink on specialization that you might have already thought of. SIP must have opened your eyes. You might have tasted the opportunities and challenges all around. That is what SIP is meant for!

Beyond this, you also need to introspect. In other words, you need to start your SWOT analysis so that you arrive to right decision for your specialization. It will also help you in preparing for interview. Recruiters assess candidates on various scales. Assessment methods are separated into various approaches rather than being summarizing into comprehensive means of understanding capability. That is why so many types of tests and interviews - Group discussion, Logical reasoning, Language, Psychometric evaluation, Handwriting analysis, Technical interview, Personal interview and so on. Let me give you some lead questions to prepare:

- Tell me about yourself.
- How did you contribute to organization where you did your SIP?
- Which is your favorite subject? Why?
- Why should we choose you? / Why do you think you are best fit for this job profile?
- Why do you want to join this company?
- Why do you want to join this company?
- Why don't you think of entrepreneurship?
- Where do you see yourself after 5 years?

- If we hire you, how long will you stay in our company?
- When did you show leadership / initiative in your life? How did it benefit you or society?

Preparation of these questions well is half work done. But that other half is tougher because it is uncertain. You cannot predict all questions. It is not interviewer but interviewee that gives lead questions to questioning team. Also, all students cannot have same answers to all questions. Hence, there is no copy paste allowed here. Give enough time to think over all of these.

On grooming side, please take care of right kind of clothes, shoes, tie etc. are available with you and ready to use. I have seen students who are struggling to get all of these an hour before interview. Sometimes, this causes harm to self confidence. These are small hurdles but can take opportunities away.

At the same time, having outfit up to date doesn't certify that you will clear interview. There are challenges related to job location (don't say – *Mala Punyatach job pahije*!), salaries, company size / popularity, internal race / competitors, unawareness of local language and many more. You have just 3 months to prepare for forthcoming placement season which commences in October.

To groom you on these aspects at faster speed, STES is planning to put you through regular, continuous Student Training Program (STP) throughout the semester. Be ready! It will start from very first day of semester!

Give a thought and start working on all of these. I am sure you will do great in your future!


