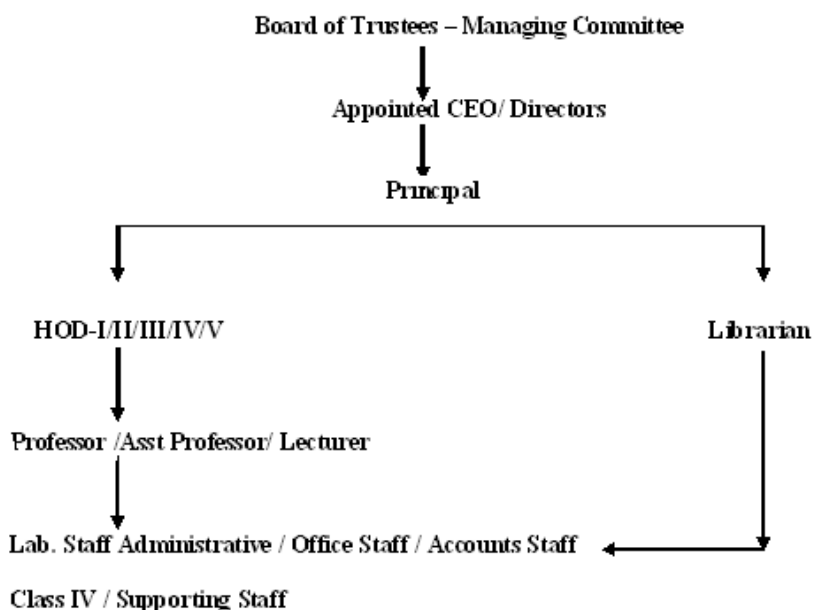
Frequency of the meeting and date of last meeting:

The evaluation sheet is to be presented to governing body during the meetings for their remarks. Thereafter the evaluation report is conveyed to each faculty.

Grievance Redressal mechanism for faculty, staff and students

STE Society has democratic setup abide by all the rules, regulations, laws related to educational institutions. Maharashtra Public University Act 2016, AICTE Act, UGC Act are the few to mention which are strictly followed along with provisions of various laws concerned with employment & employees welfare as well.

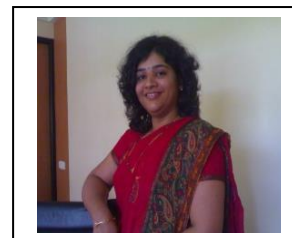

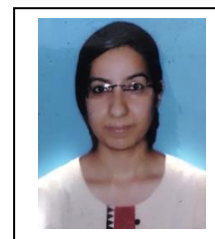

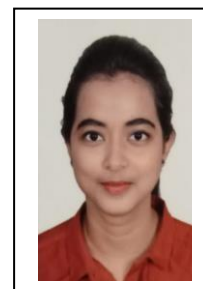

Internal Continuous Evaluation System and place:

Total assessment in our institute consists of In semester continuous assessment and End semester assessment (semester end examination). All the efforts are made to design the pattern of continuous internal evaluation more realistic giving account of learner's ability to grasp the subject. It mainly consists of modules (Assignments, Case studies, Open book test, Class tests, etc.) and a sessional examination. As the M. Pharmacy curriculum is based partly on papers and partly by research more emphasis is given to **improve communication skills** in the students. In the first and second semester, students are required to give seminar on topics from the respected semester's syllabus. In third semester, one seminar on "Plan of work for research work" and other on "Journal Club" is conducted. In fourth semester student is expected to present the research work completed till date.

Workload of learner consists of Lecture hours (Face to face teaching) plus **notional learner work load** (reading, discussions, assignments). Thus, if a student has attended all the classroom teaching or lectures for a course it does not mean that he has earned 100% credit assigned for the course as it has to include the notional workload of the learner. Performance of the learner is reported in the form of grades than marks. **Grading** not only allows a comparison of the performance but it also indicates the quality of performance, amount of efforts put in and knowledge acquired at the end of the course.


