Report On “Tree Saplings Distribution”

Place: Savitribai Phule Pune University,, Pune

Date: 23/06/2019

The Savitribai Phule Pune University (SPPU) Sunday on 23rd June attempted to create a Guinness World record by distributing 16,631 saplings of neem to volunteers of the National Service Scheme (NSS), linked to more than 350 colleges under the University. The saplings are likely to be planted along the route taken by warkaris during Ashadhi Wari .

With the record attempt, the SPPU announced the start of its ‘Green Wari’ initiative, which combines ecological awareness with the larger objective of promoting conservation of water resources and regenerating the tree cover. Students wore four-colour T-shirts during the event and formed the National Flag.

Our Chief Minister Devendra Fadnavis, Guardian Minister Chandrakant Patil, Mayor Mukta Tilak, District Collector Naval Kishore Ram and SSPU Vice Chancellor Nitin Karmalkar, among others, were present at the event.

Fadnavis, who also administered an oath to participating NSS volunteers for ensuring a ‘Green Wari’ this year, said the pilgrimage has a tradition of more than 700 years and it should be a matter of privilege for students to be able to contribute towards making the journey of warkaris easier and more fulfilling.

VC Karmalkar said, “Attempting the world record is not a goal in itself. The goal is to make the wari more environmentally friendly.

All this will be monitored by a qualified group of practicing lawyers,” said Mr. Pande. “There will be a serving officer to monitor the whole process and he would be assisted by a reputed auditing firm at the venue.

Report on Fort conservation event

Every community and society has a very precious heritage which has to be and can be transferred to the next generation. The monuments we can get a glimpse of India's past through these monuments. With their elaborate superfluities and wonderful architecture, Indian monuments represent one of the most outstanding facets of the Indian culture. But simply possessing them are not enough. Preserving them should be equally prioritised. It is disheartening to see people, forgetting that they are doing an irreparable damage to these archaeological masterpieces, throwing trash, inscribe their initials, names, or messages on these national treasures.

In order to further strengthen the commitment for protection of monuments, we members of NSS team decided to conduct a cleanliness drive at one most famous fort in Maharashtra the Rajgad fort located in pune district. At first two senior volunteers were hired to survey the place first just to ensure safety and check willing of other volunteers to trek. So after getting a green signal we finalised our destined to Rajgad fort. And the day was finalised on 12th of feb 2020 to go.

Finally the day arrived we departed at 5 am in morning from the front gate of our college. It was too early so breakfast poha and cup of tea was provided to all volunteers. Everyone was energised and excited. Then we seated in our bus and started our journey towards our great destiny. Around 6:30 we arrived at base of the Rajgad fort. With the thrill and radiant energy we were ready to climb the fort. We started from gunjavane (chor darwaza) to trek. It was a blissful morning we enjoyed while trekking. Sooner we reached at padmavati temple around at 8:30am there we halted to have some snacks and to quench our thirst for which we were carrying 4 water jars. We also carried a first aid kit to avoid medical emergency if in any case of injury to anyone. When we touched to the fort soil had some different kind of energy which took away all our tiredness and we were ready to get started with our main purpose of arrival, the cleanliness drive. We wore the gloves and began to collect the trash and plastic waste and cleaned surrounding premises heading towards the padmavati maachi (suvela maachi). The dirt and dust did not deter spirit of any volunteers and they took part in the cleanliness drive enthusiastically. There were two reasons behind to conduct this drive one was, of course, to conserve the fort, and the second was to promote the initiative, 'Swachh Bharat'. We believe that Clean, Happy and Healthy Citizens impart Healthy and Developed Nation. Every volunteer were willingly participating in picking up paper and plastic and sweeping.

Report On “Free Health Check Up Camp ”

Venue: Reading Hall , Sae

Date: 25/07/2019

On 25th of September ‘FREE HEALTH CHECK UP CAMP’ was conducted at SAOE. Camp was conducted in the presence of Dr.K.P.Patil (Principal SAOE), K.M.Gaikwad (Vice Principal SAOE), Prof.A.Rajguru(NSS Program Officer), Respected HOD’s of all Department, all the faculty members, all non teaching staff and students. It also involved NSS members from all the departments. Honorable Principal Dr .K .P. Patil Sir did the inauguration of the Health Check Up Camp. This is organized in cooperation with ONEMG private limited company. HEALTH CHECKUP CAMP was then organized at reading hall from 12 pm to 4pm. Tests that were conducted are as follows:

1.Thyroid (TSH) : A **TSH test** is done to find out if your **thyroid** gland is working the way it should. ... If untreated, a **thyroid** disorder can cause health problems. **TSH** stands for “**thyroid stimulating hormone**” and the **test** measures how much of this hormone is in your blood. **TSH** is produced by the pituitary gland in your brain

2.Bone Profile

a. Calcium : A **calcium blood test** measures the amount of **calcium** in your blood. ... About 99% of your body's **calcium** is stored in your **bones**. The remaining 1% circulates in the blood. If there is too much or too little **calcium** in the blood, it may be a sign of **bone** disease, thyroid disease, kidney disease, or other medical conditions.

b. Phosphorous : A **phosphate test** measures the amount of **phosphate** in a **blood** sample. **Phosphate** is a charged particle (ion) that contains the mineral **phosphorus**. The body needs **phosphorus** to build and repair **bones** and teeth, help nerves function, and make muscles contract. ... The kidneys help control the amount of **phosphate** in the **blood**.

c. Alkaline Phosphorous : An **alkaline phosphatase (ALP) test** measures the amount of **ALP** in your blood. **ALP** is an enzyme found throughout the body, but it is mostly found in the liver, **bones**, kidneys, and digestive system. ... High levels of **ALP** can indicate liver disease or **bone** disorders

About 151 samples was collected and 151 peoples health checkup was done. After Health Checkup Feedback of every person was taken.

“Flood Relief Campaign”

DATE: 26th & 27th / 09/2019

Between September 25–28, 2019, [Pune](#), India, and its division received a heavy amount of rainfall which caused flash flooding. Heavy rains lashed Pune city and other neighboring areas on **25th SEPTEMBER**, 2019 night throwing normal life out of gear in many places. Rain stopped on **26th SEPTEMBER**, 2019 morning, but many houses and residential societies , colleges in low-lying areas were still inundated. There were several reports of wall collapse and uprooting of trees in those places, adding that several vehicles were also swept away in the flood waters.

SINHGAD ACADEMY OF ENGINEERING ,KONDHWA was among one of those places which were affected by HEAVY RAINFALL on on **25th SEPTEMBER** ,2019 night . The compound wall of the college collapsed due to heavy rainfall and water logged into college area. It majorly affected hostel and college buildings. Ground floor of college and hostel was under water. Water logged into library creating mess in it and all the books were also under water. Rooms of boys hostel and girls hostel were also flooded and students were shift to higher floors of the hostel.

Next day i.e on 26th of September ,2019 the level of water decreased and mess was created in all the affected areas generating foul smell. All the Members of NSS and College Authorities gathered in college and decided to clean this mess by their own. NSS team firstly shifted all the books from library so as to reduce damage caused. All the books were then gathered and dried.

As the wall was collapsed and due to heavy rain fall all the reptiles like snake entered in college lawn. One of the member of NSS Mr. AMAN KUMAR TIWARI reported the situation immediately to college authorities and called SARAP MITRA. All the reptiles were then safely moved.

The next task was to clean the mess in the library and hostel. All the students then cleaned hostel and library. This work continued next day also i.e on 27th of SEPTEMBER ,2019.

The college was then back to normal within two days with the help of NSS team. Due to quick action taken by all the college authorities and NSS team members major problems that might had occurred was avoided

Later the work of all NSS team members was appreciated by college authorities. All the students were awarded with certificates from college by Dr.K.P.Patil sir (Principal SAOE), K.M.Gaikwad sir (Vice Principal SAOE), Respected HOD's of all Department in presence of all the faculty members and students.

Second round:

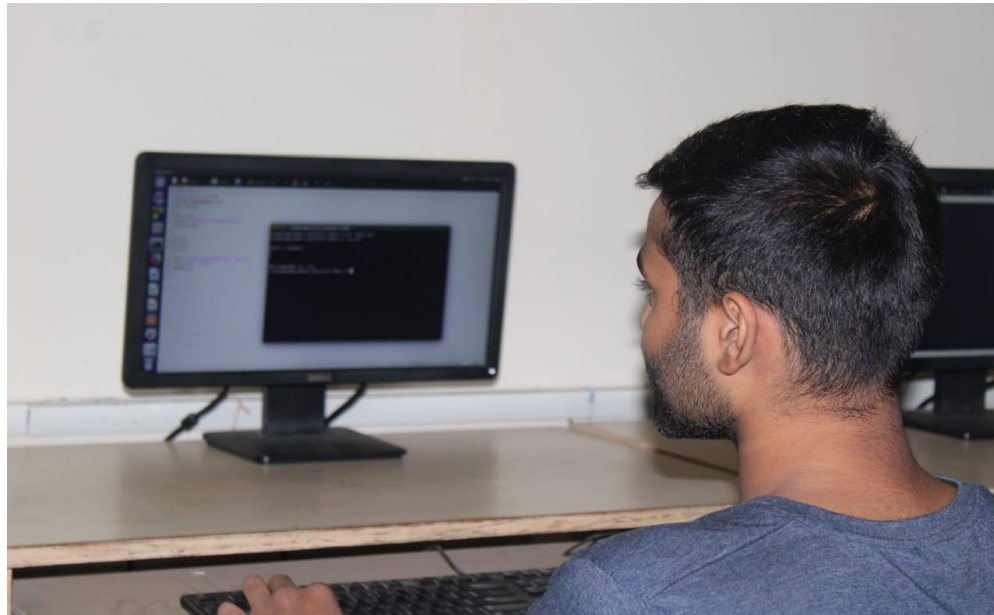
As it was final round we increased the difficulty of the codes and now the time limit was decreased.
