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
Student Satisfaction Survey Report (2021-2022)

Sinhgad Institute of Business Administration and Research (SIBAR) is committed towards all-round development of the students. The institute always conducts co-curricular and extra-curricular activities for the holistic development of students. The institute organizes industry visits, cultural events, sports events, group discussions, workshops, seminars, and many learner oriented activities. The institute considers the inputs and feedback from the students very important to bring relevant and fruitful changes in the institute. The student feedback considerably showcases the actual quality of teaching-learning process thereby enabling identification of the strengths of teaching as well as the possible areas for improvement.

The students were highly satisfied with the faculty, syllabus coverage, teaching methodology, faculty interaction with the students, internships and the facilities provided by the institute.






What program are you pursuing now?

- 0 –Below 30%


95% students said that 85 to 100 % syllabus was covered in the class


91% students said that teachers prepared thoroughly for the classes.


87% students said that the teacher’s communication was always effective.










87% students said that the teaching and mentoring process in the institution facilitates in cognitive, social and emotional growth.










82 % students said that the teachers fully identify their strengths and encourage them with providing right level of challenges








83% students said that teachers encourage them to participate in extracurricular activities


85% students said that efforts are made by the institute/ teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make them ready for the world of work to a great extent.
