A seminar on “Geographical Indication -A form of Intellectual Property” was organized under Institution Innovation Council, SIBAR-MCA on 7<sup>th</sup> July 2022.

The objective of the Seminar was to make students aware of the Geographical Indications so that they can identify the products of a particular origin, think of identifying products/natural products from their places that they can suggest for GI tagging and making the market available for those products of quality. The students can create and use various designs/products and try to gain some monetary value out of it in terms of reputation, Intellectual property and they can be “Vocal for Local” with the knowledge of Geographical Indication, which helps them to understand & design and how to implement this knowledge into a user friendly way to create some benefit to the society..

The seminar was delivered by Ms Pramodini Dange, TIFAC-WOS-C, KIRAN IPR, Assistant Professor, SIBAR, Pune.

The seminar started by the short introduction of the speaker Prof. Pramodini Dange and her felicitation by the hands of Dr.Netra Patil Mam, Director, SIBAR-MCA .

The key objective of the seminar was to motivate students for creating an awareness on Geographical Indication with ideas that relate to their local region wise GI indicators (“Every Region has its Claim to fame”)

Prof. Pramodini Dange has elaborated on GI products of different regions of India and their importance how to build or generate a new idea to create any kind of by-products of existing things or create new knowledge on top of it, also discussed few case studies on Solapur Pomegranate, and its by-products like Tropicana w.r.t manufacturing industries, and the importance of maintaining climate conditions suitable for the product of quality.

Few more case studies on Tirupati Laddu of Tirumala Tirupati Devasthanams, AndhraPradesh State, and about Darjeeling Tea were discussed. Also provided information on total no of GI registered in Maharashtra state are only 33 from April 2004 to March 2022, discussed on WHY GI tagging knowledge is important to current generation students and how to implement it.

**Key Outcome:**

The seminar was fruitful to the students as they very well understood and promised to implement the knowledge gained and to enhance their skills in GI area.

In trail with this seminar a social media contest is announced to promote Geographical Indications/products of origin that will be open from 8th July to 25th July 2022.
