- **Human Rights Violations:** This includes information on any human rights violations or abuses that have occurred, including torture, extrajudicial killings, and enforced disappearances
- **.Accountability and Justice:** This includes information on efforts to hold perpetrators of human rights violations accountable and ensure that victims receive justice.
- It is important to ensure that the information presented in a human rights report is based on reliable and credible sources, such as government reports, international human rights organizations, and local human rights defenders. The report should also provide recommendations on how to address any human rights abuses and promote the protection and fulfillment of human rights.

After a completion of successful event we conducted a test on Human Rights for the all participants students.

Later the dais distributed the participation certificates to the participants students.

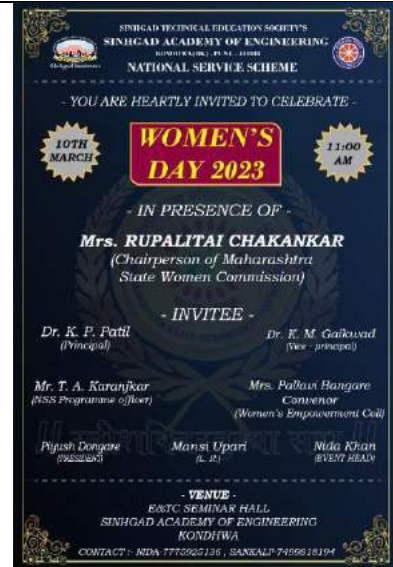

The working staff of the health centre was very helpful and supportive towards all the volunteers and very happily providing all the help required.

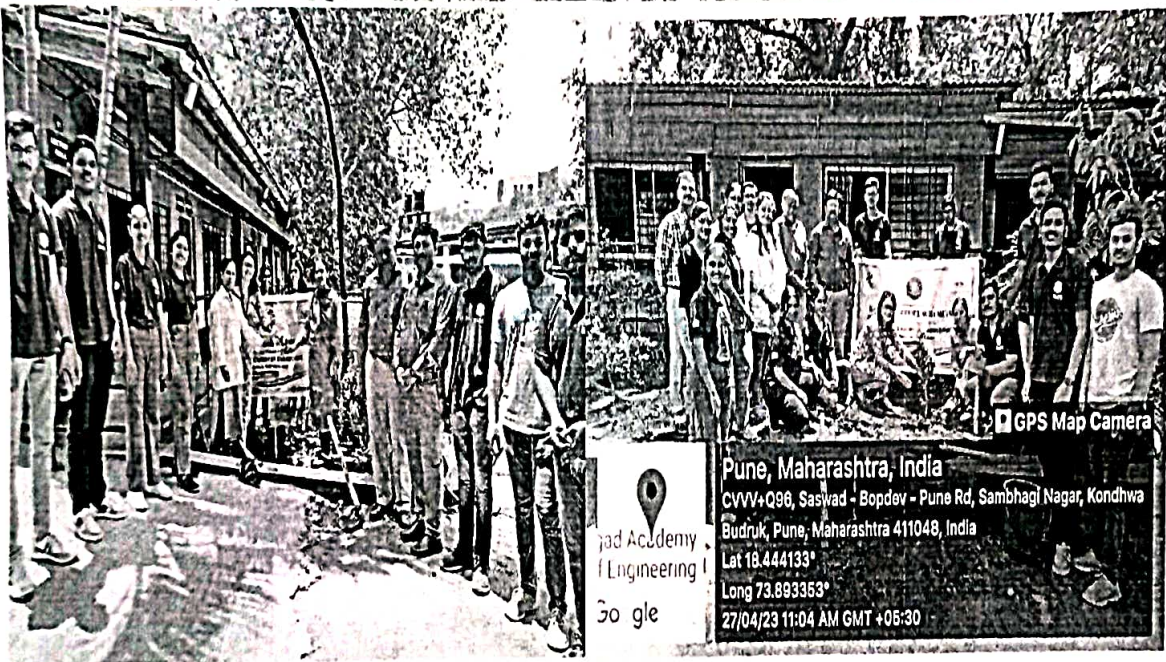
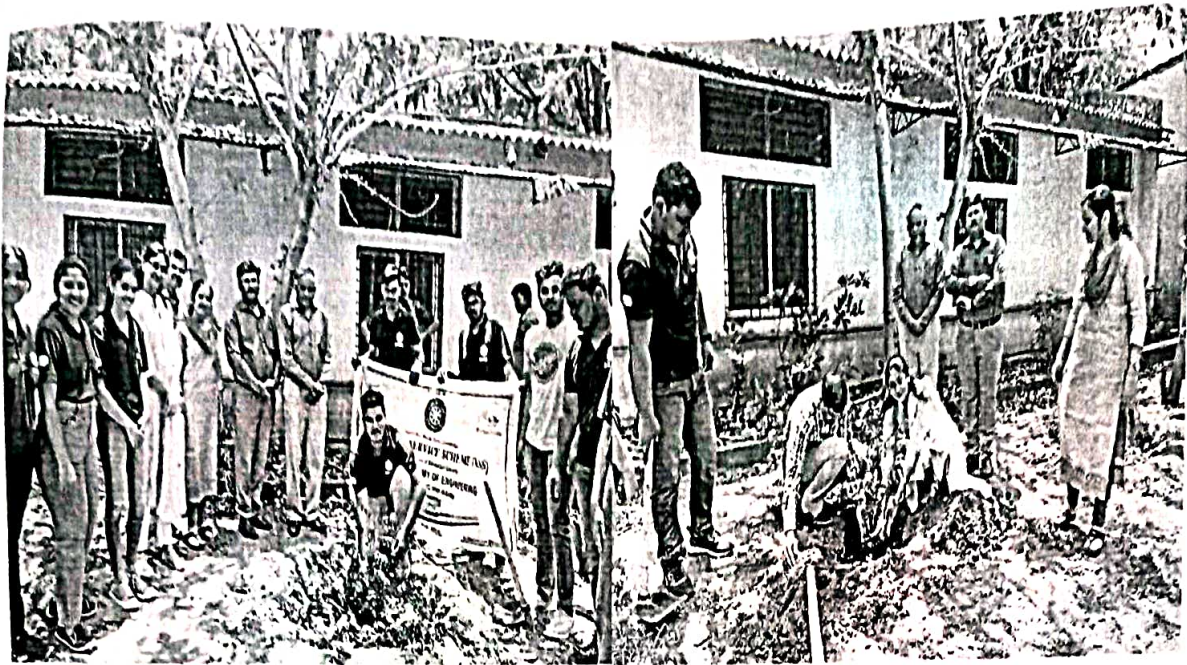
