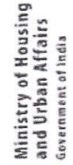

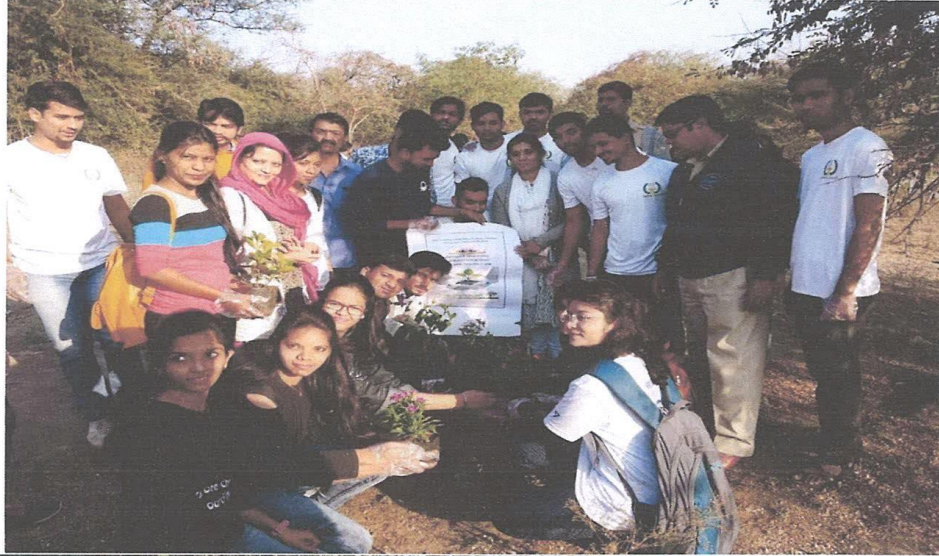

Introduction:

Dr.Roza Parashar introduced this CSR program and the initiative taken by SKNSSBM as below:

Faster up gradation of electronic product is forcing consumers to discard old electronic products very quickly, which, in turn, adds to e-waste to the solid waste stream. The growing problem of e-waste calls for greater emphasis on recycling e-waste and better e-waste management. Reducing the use of plastic is important because plastic production requires an enormous amount of energy and resources. This causes carbon emissions and contributes to global warming. Recycling plastic is not efficient – only 9% of plastic ever produced has been recycled. About 60% is discarded in landfills and oceans. There, it stays for thousands of years, transforming into "micro plastic," leaching into our water supplies and food. People tend to switch over to the newer models and the life of products has also decreased. Reduce, Reuse, Recycle (3Rs) is the model we can students & staff together make awareness about this to society.

SKNSSBM will always play vital role towards issues in society.

Inauguration of programme:

Dr.Prachi Pargaonkar welcomed the guest and inaugurated the drive she added that Adar Poonawala clean initiative and Janwani NGO approached for this event and we decided to organize this drive, 40 student volunteers registered for this event to create awareness and collection of E-waste and Plastic waste at 8 given locations in Sinhgad Road and at our institute SKNSSBM on 19th December 2021.

Session was very insightful and Interactive various points were discussed such as:

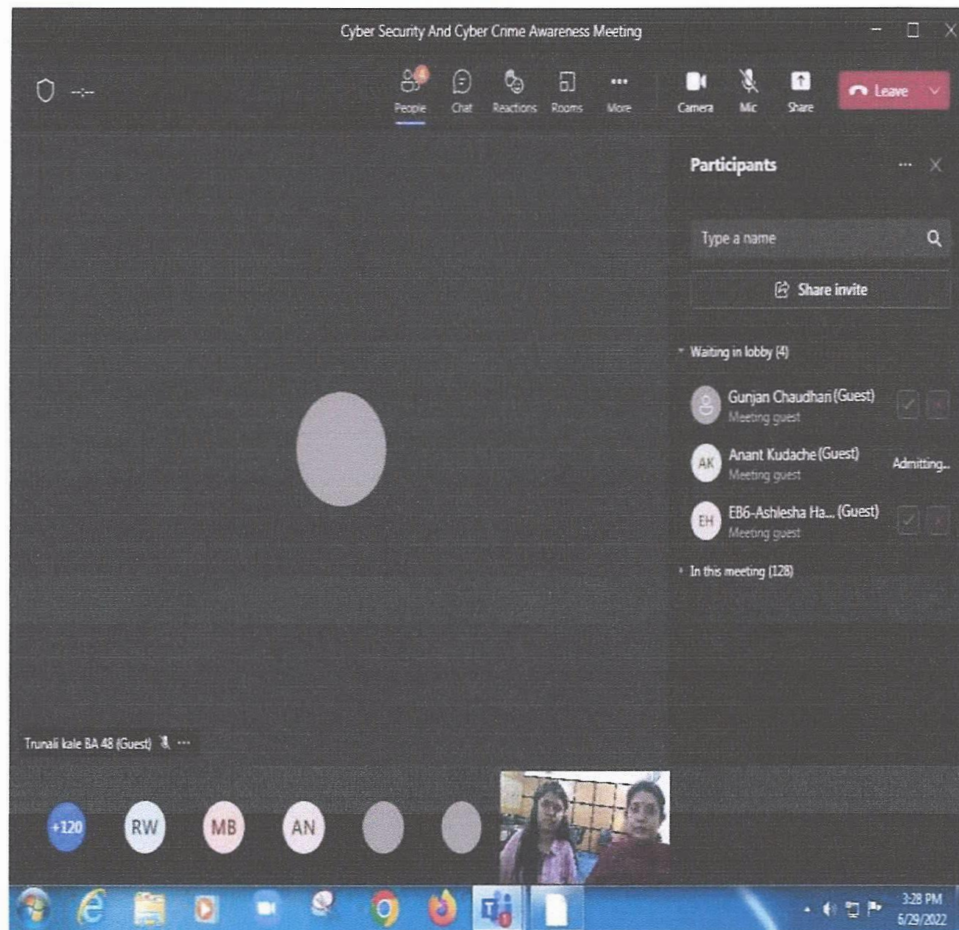

Intersectionality: The concept of intersectionality was explored, demonstrating how various identities intersect with gender to influence an individual's experiences.


Outcomes and Impact:
