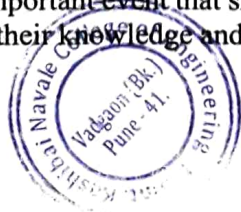
We have administrative and academic bodies for students, run by students under which various activities are conducted to help students for overall development and it creates a more efficient learning environment in many ways.

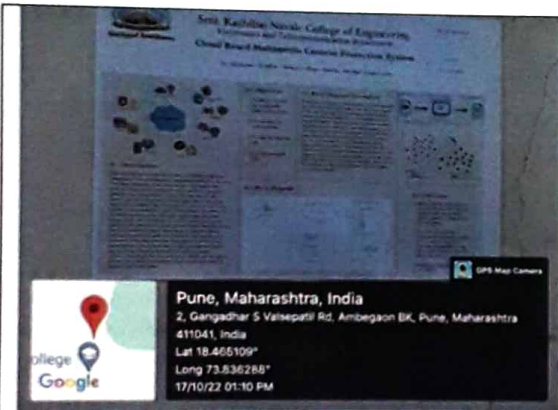
